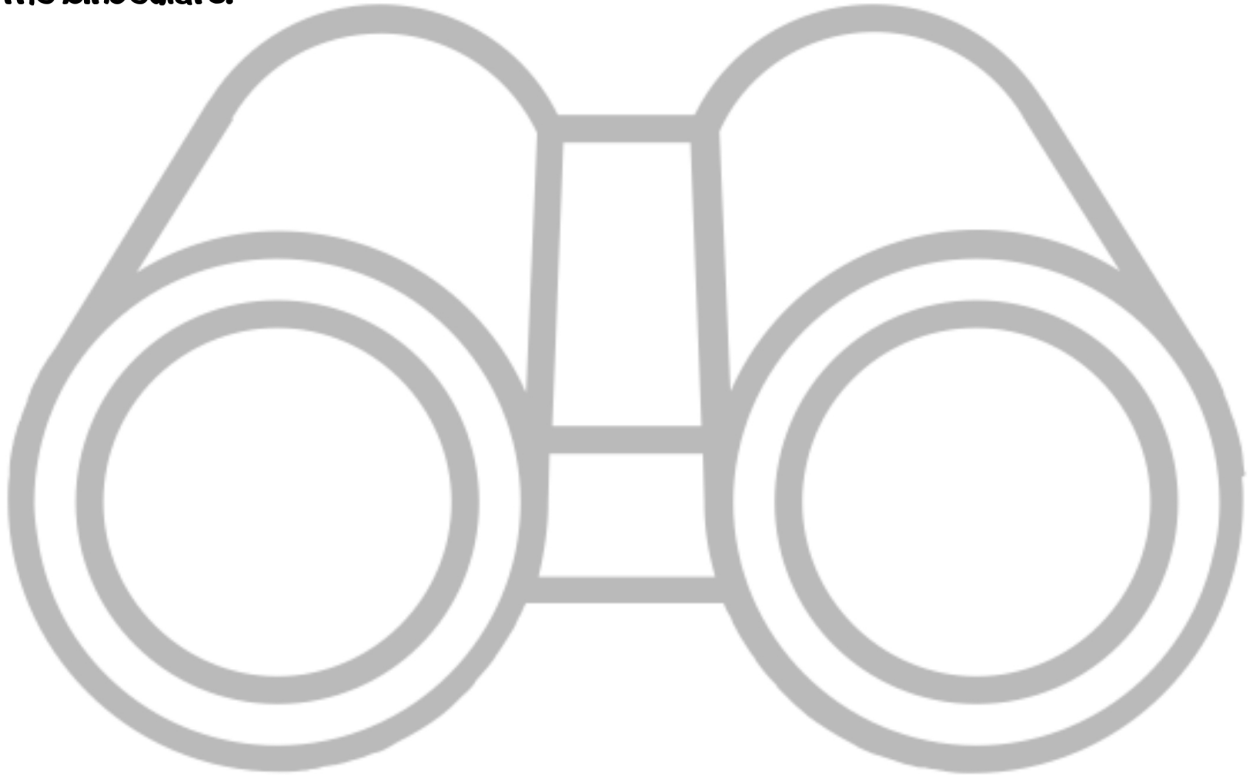

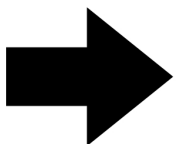
1: DIN - OCULARS

2: DINO-FYING GLASS

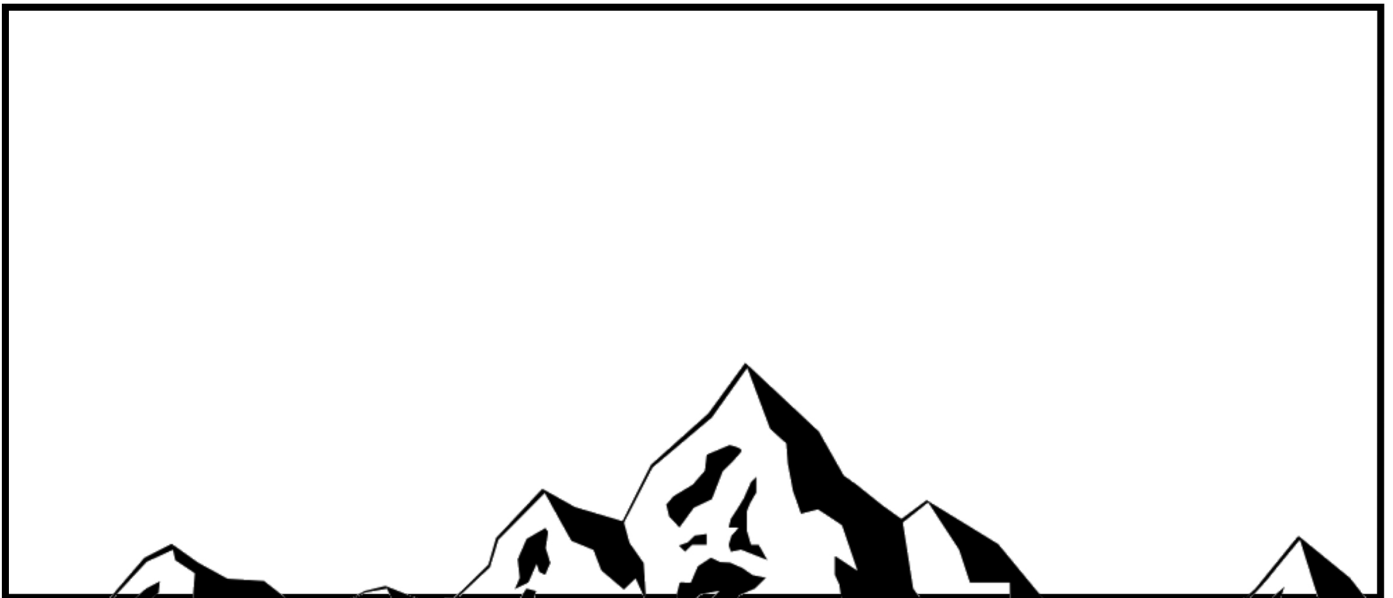


If your **Dinosaur** had a magnifying glass, that makes tiny things much bigger, what would they see on the ground?

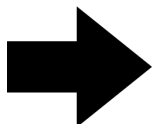


Draw what your **Dinosaur** can see in here...

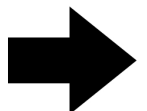
3: DINO WORLDS

Make a Dinosaur world using things you find in your house or garden – Could a cushion be a hill? A towel be a river? A broccoli be a tree?

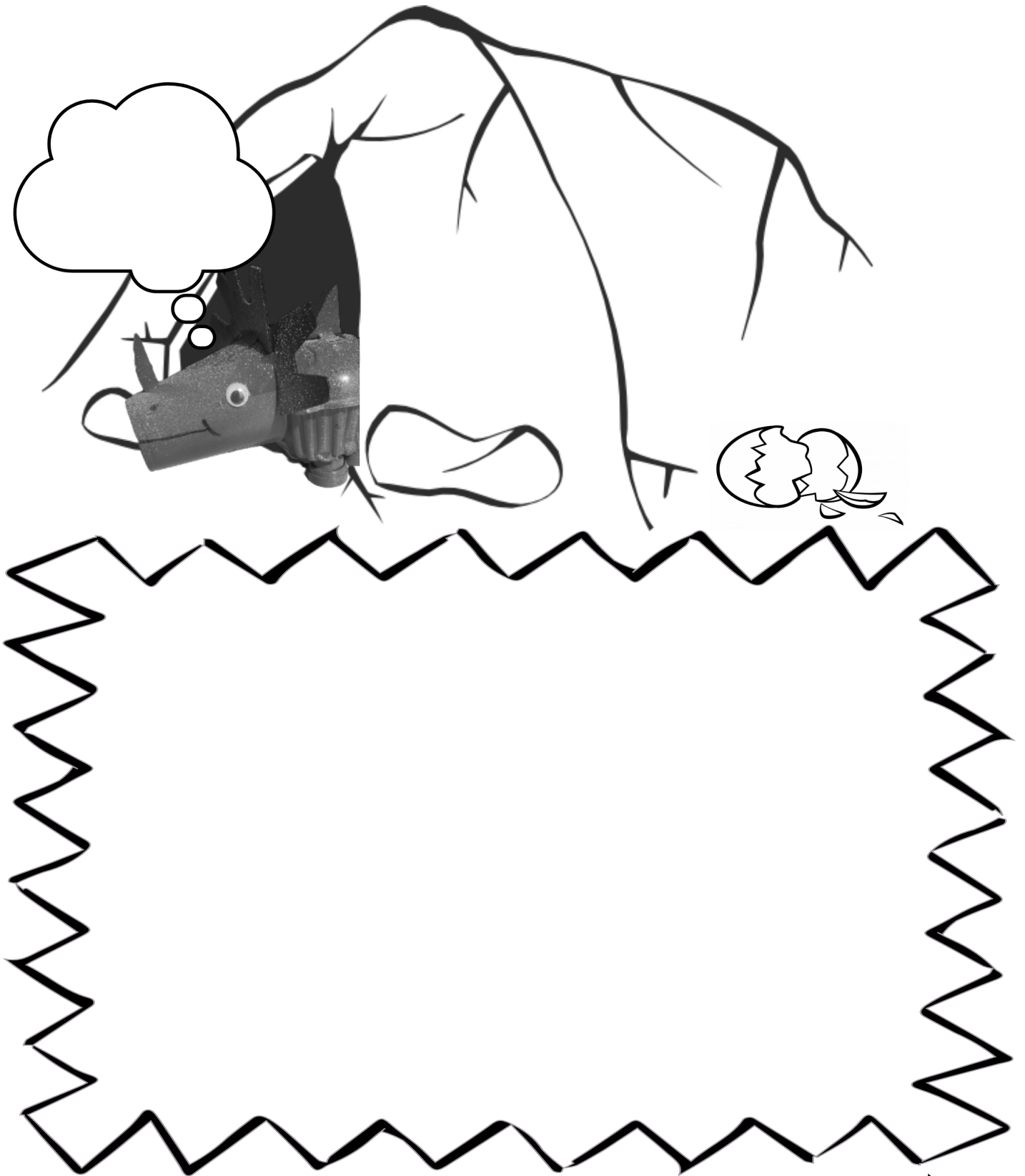

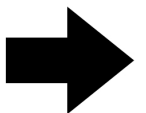


4: DINO - HOUSE

5. MAKE A DINOSAUR DEN

you need:   

We have made a den for our Dinosaur. We'd like you to make one for yours – follow the steps below, but make it your own – it doesn't have to look like ours.

STEP 1:

For our den we used a shoe box. We cut one side out. Then, we used another piece of cardboard for the front of the den..



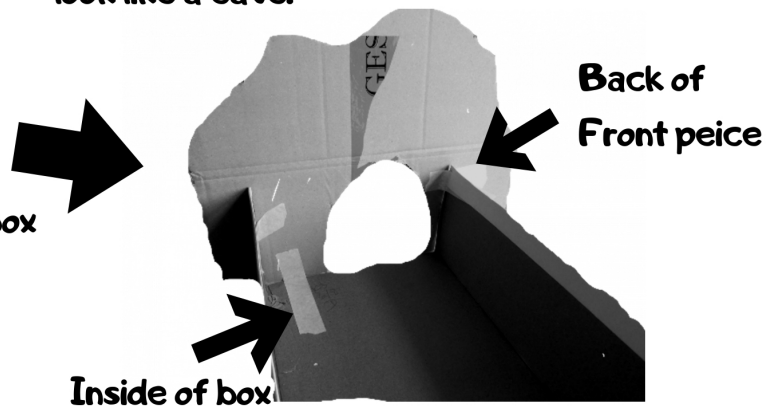
STEP 2:

We decided to paint our den to make it look like a cave.



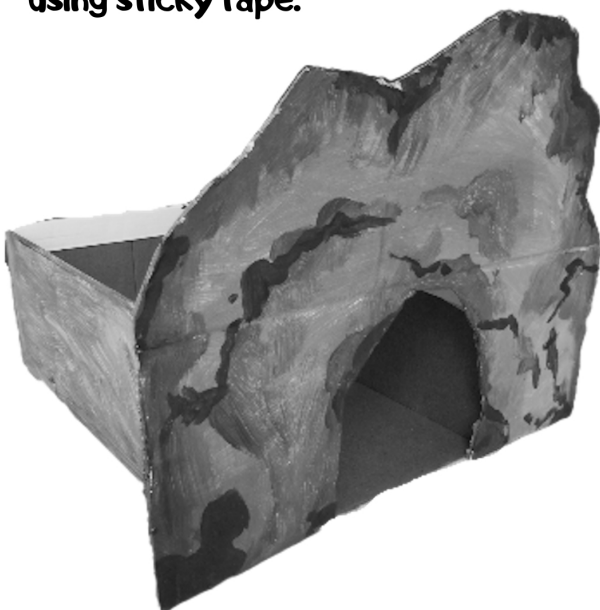
STEP 3:

We stuck the front of the den to the box using sticky tape.



STEP 4:

To finish off, we also painted the sides of the box.

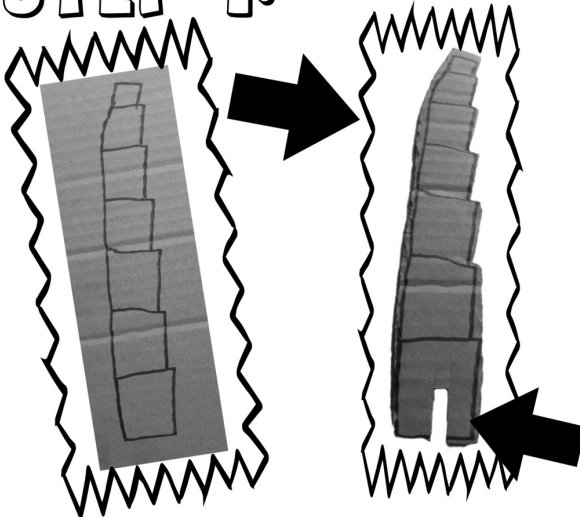


NEXT STEPS 

6. MAKE A DINOSAUR PLANT:

Now we are going to make a plant for your Dinosaur World. Something your Dinosaur can sit under, or eat, or scratch thier back on....remember, you can make it look however you want.

STEP 1:



Draw a tree trunk on a peice of card. Make sure that the card is strong. You may need to stick two peices together.

Cut it out and cut a little gap at the bottom - you might need an adult to help you with this bit!

Cut out a gap

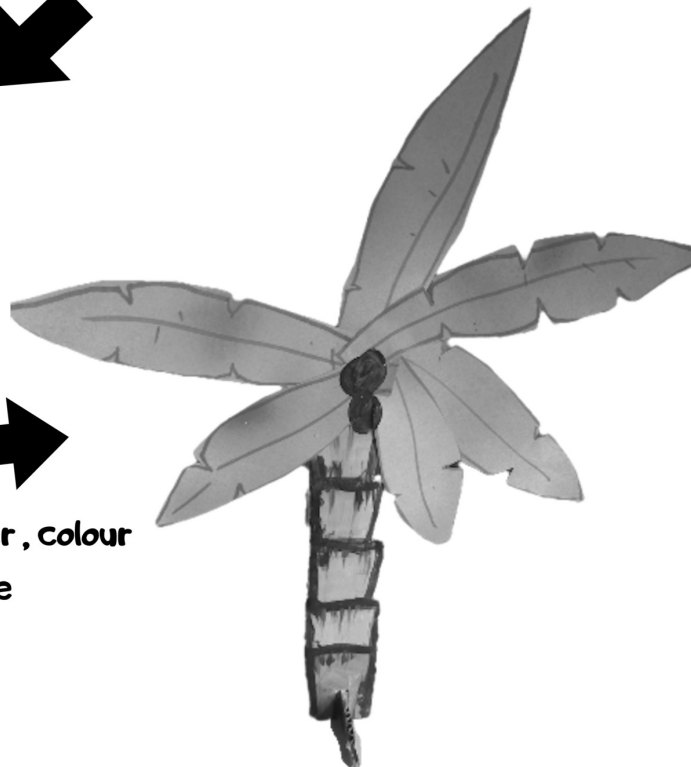
STEP 2:



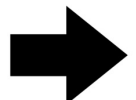
Cut a small peice of card and slide it into the gap. Stick it there with some tape. Then, paint your tree trunk.

STEP 3:

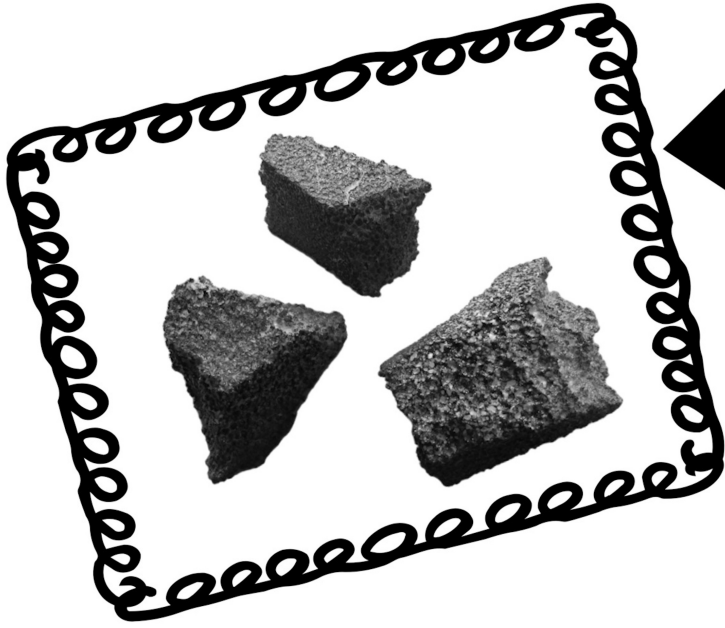
Draw and cut out some leaf shapes using paper , colour them in and stick them to the top of the tree trunk.



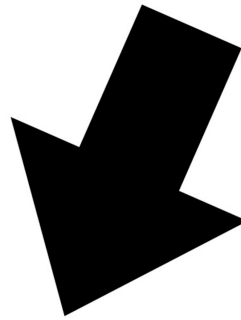
FINAL STEP

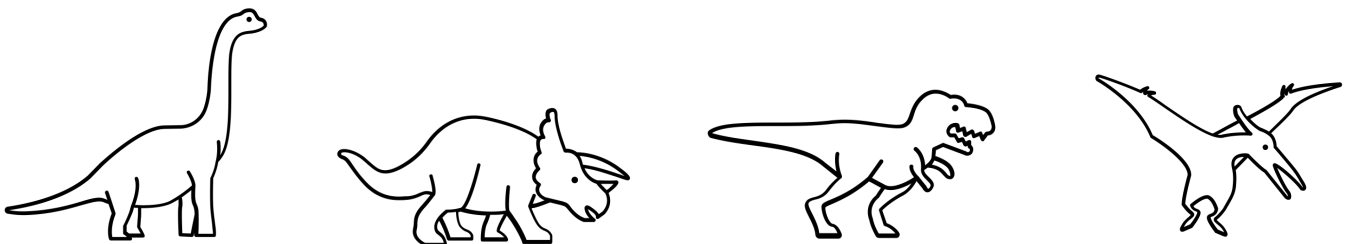
